4 Select the Doctor’s name.


Overall Star Rating




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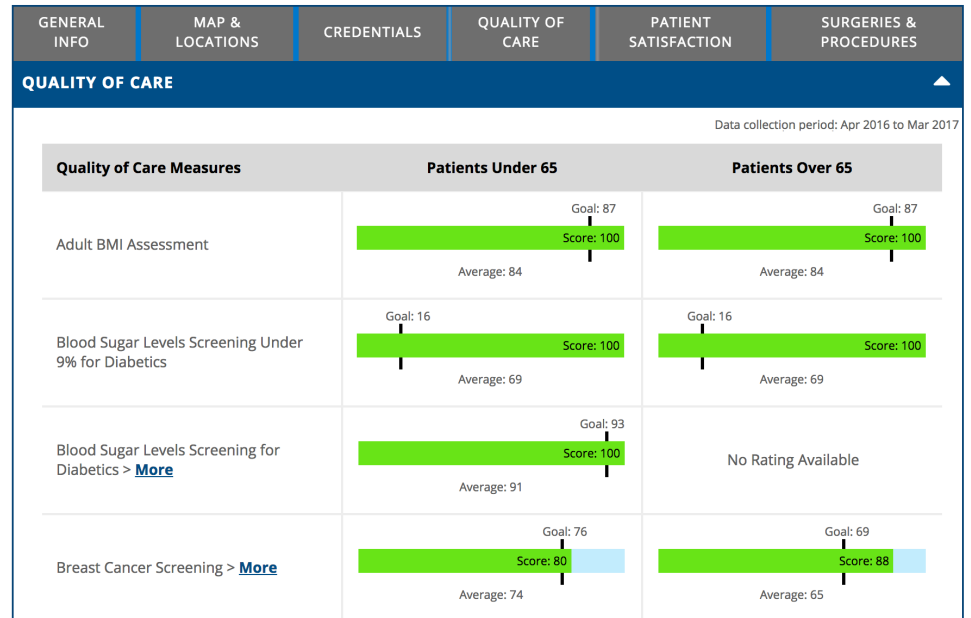

Quality of Care Tab

When you select the link that appears under “Quality of Care,” you will see new data that aligns with the data presented in the PPA, including:

- **Composite Clinical Ratings**

Two Composite Clinical Star Ratings are shown, one that represents care for patients under 65 and another one for patients 65 and older.

The Composite Clinical Star Rating compares the provider’s average of all applicable measures against thresholds to determine 1-Star, 2-Star and 3-Star ratings.

A 3-Star rating is the highest star level and reflects a provider that meets the threshold to qualify for the Clinical Effectiveness (Quality) category in value-based programs.

- **Measure Ratings**

The graphic displayed to the right of the measure name shows the provider’s performance (score) related to his or her peer group (Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama providers in the same specialty) and also the national or Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services goal set for each measure. The graph reflects three types of results:

- **Score** – Doctor’s score based on how often the doctor’s patients with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama coverage received services.
- **Average** – Average score for doctors with similar specialties in Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Alabama’s network.
- **Goal** – Average percent of patients enrolled in PPO plans nationwide (patients under 65 years of age) or patients enrolled in Medicare or Medicare Advantage programs (patients 65 years or older) that receive these services.
